3rd place 4 points
4th place 3 points

6th place 1 point

RULES

Competition run under BRC Rules for Dressage

All classes are open to adults and juniors.

Class 1 A and B

Section A - for those who have not competed in affiliated dressage or horse trials nor come first in any open dressage/combined training competition.

Section B - open.

Entry forms should be sent to the Secretary together with the correct fees - £7 TDRRC members/£8 non-members per class. Cheques should be made payable to Taunton & District Riding Club.

Please enter early as class sizes are restricted.

Rosettes are awarded to 6th place, with a special rosette to the highest placed TDRRC member, and to only 3rd place where there are seven or less entries in a class.

Please remove all droppings and leave the car park tidy.

No responsibility can be taken by the organiser or landowner for any accident to competitors, horses, spectators or property.

The judge's decision is final.
