All classes are open to adults and juniors.

Class 1 A and B

Section A - for those who have not competed in
affiliated dressage or horse trials nor come first in any
open dressage/combined training competition.

Section B - open.

Entry forms should be sent to the Secretary together
with the correct fees - £7 TDRC members/£8 non-
members per class. Cheques should be made payable to
Taunton & District Riding Club.

Please enter early as class sizes are restricted.

Rosettes are awarded to 6th place, with a special
rosette to the highest placed TDRC member, and to only
3rd place where there are seven or less entries in a class.

Please remove all droppings and leave the car park
tidy.

landowner for any accident to competitors, horses,
spectators or property.
